# **Rich Heritage, Priceless Views**



### **Des Pères Road**

Des Pères Road connects the town of Magog with the municipality of Saint-Benoît-du-Lac, home to the famous abbey of the same name. The road itself is known for its majestic views of Lake Memphremagog and the surrounding valley. Owl's Head Mountain slowly reveals itself to those winding their way south. Travellers headed north are treated to stunning views of Mount Orford, not to mention the town of Magog. Check your rear-view mirror from time to time to make sure you don't miss a thing!

## **Knowlton's Landing Wharf**

The hamlet of Knowlton's Landing on the shores of Lake Memphremagog bears witness to the Knowlton family's arrival in the region. The family eventually settled some 20 km further east, in the village that bears their name. Until the arrival of the railway, anyone travelling between Montreal and Boston had to pass through Knowlton's Landing, before or after crossing the lake by ferry. The building now known as Chalet l'Aubergine became an important stop on the stagecoach route. From the wharf, enjoy the lovely views of Lake Memphremagog and Owl's Head Mountain.
