



Haskell Free Library and Opera House

Founded in 1901, the Haskell Free Library and Opera House serves the cultural needs of people living on both sides of the Canada-US border, in both English and French. It ensures access to information and reading material, provides a broad range of services, offers diverse programming, and supports the visual and performing arts. As a heritage building and a cultural centre, the Haskell Free Library and Opera House play a crucial role in enriching the lives of its members and the community.

Prepare to be impressed! The Queen Anne-style building straddles the international border, which is marked by black line on the floor. The building entrance is on the American side. However, visitors can park at 6 Phelps Street in the town of Stanstead, on the Canadian side, and proceed to the entrance under the watchful eye of border officers. Guided tours for groups available by reservation.

Des Pères Road

Des Pères Road connects the town of Magog with the municipality of Saint-Benoît-du-Lac, home to the famous abbey of the same name. The road itself is known for its majestic views of Lake Memphremagog and the surrounding valley. Owl's Head Mountain slowly reveals itself to those winding their way south. Travellers headed north are treated to stunning views of Mount Orford, not to mention the town of Magog. Check your rear-view mirror from time to time to make sure you don't miss a thing!
