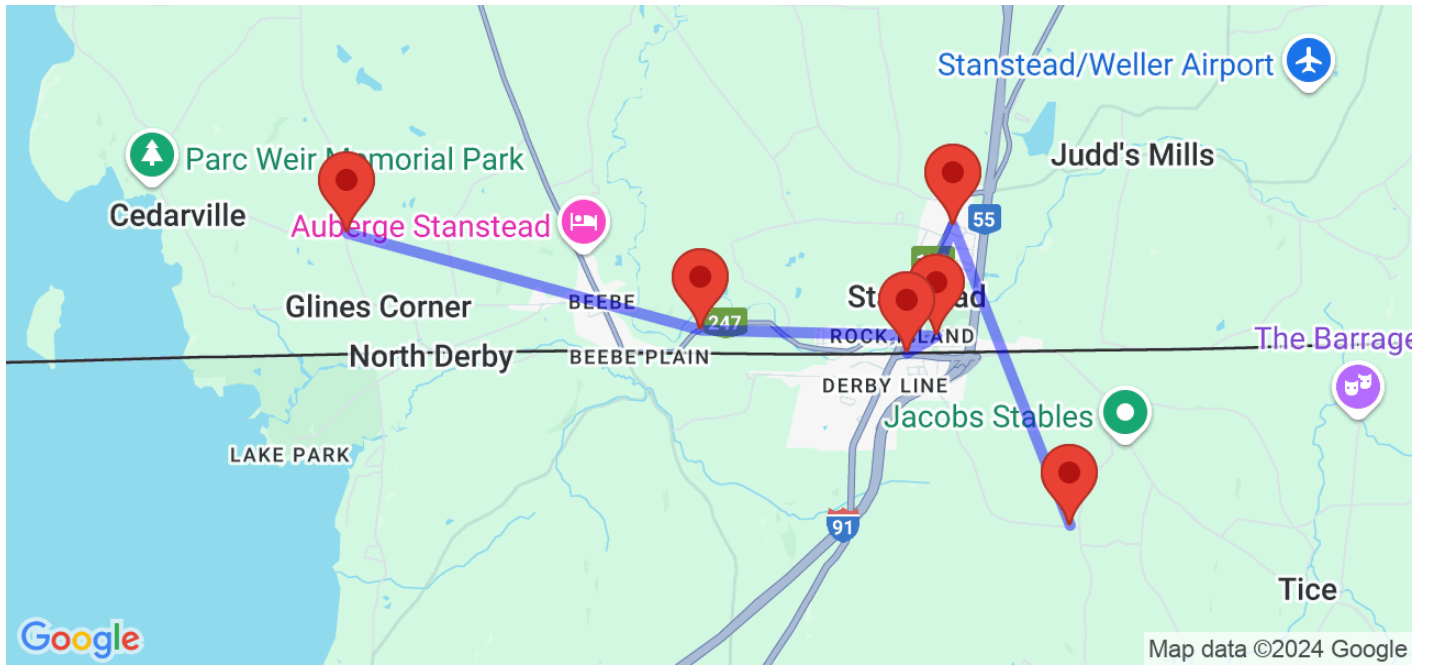

Cercle de pierres de Stanstead

Le Cercle de pierres de Stanstead rappelle le cercle de Stonehenge en Angleterre est une mise en valeur du granite de la région. Localisé sur le 45e parallèle il a été créé en 2009, c'est un parc où l'on peut marcher le long de la rivière et assister durant la saison estivale à quelques événements culturels organisés par la Ville de Stanstead.

Cet arrêt fait parti de la Voie des Pionniers, un circuit qui permet d'apprendre grâce à une stèle et d'une capsule audio, sur des personnages qui ont marqué l'histoire de nos villages. Au Cercle de pierres on apprend sur la vie d'Henrietta Ball-Banting (1912-1976) une médecin pas comme les autres.

As a heritage building and a cultural centre, the Haskell Free Library and Opera House play a crucial role in enriching the lives of its members and the community.

Prepare to be impressed! The Queen Anne-style building straddles the international border, which is marked by black line on the floor. The building entrance is on the American side. However, visitors can park at 6 Phelps Street in the town of Stanstead, on the Canadian side, and proceed to the entrance under the watchful eye of border officers.
